VILLAGE OF BIRCH RUN ORDINANCE NO. 97-5

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE VILLAGE OF BIRCH RUN ZONING ORDINANCE, ADOPTED SEPTEMBER 1988, AS AMENDED, BY AMENDING SECTION 503, "TEMPORARY SIGNS," OF CHAPTER 5, "SIGN REGULATIONS" BY ADDING SECTION 503(D), "STREET BANNERS" THERETO.

THE VILLAGE OF BIRCH RUN ORDAINS:

Section 1. Addition of Section 503(D), "Street Banners." Section 503, entitled "Temporary Signs," of Chapter 5, entitled "Sign Regulations," of the Village of Birch Run Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended by adding Section 503(D) to read as follows:

- (D) STREET BANNERS. Street banners shall be permitted by the Village Council upon an application containing the following:
 - (1) Identification of the specific location(s) of the banner(s), which location(s) are subject to change in the discretion of the Village Council;
 - (2) Evidence of proper wind load design for the location(s);
 - (3) Proof of general liability insurance in the amount of \$500,000 which includes the Village of Birch Run as an additional named insured;
 - (4) Other information determined by the Village Council to be necessary; and
 - (5) Payment of an application fee established by resolution of the Village Council.

Unless otherwise determined by the Village Council, street banners shall be installed by the Village, or its designee, no more than fourteen (14) days prior to the public entertainment or activity and shall be removed within forty-eight (48) hours after the conclusion of said entertainment or activity.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Severability.</u> If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

<u>Section 3.</u> Savings. All proceedings pending and all rights and liability existing, acquired, or incurred at the time this ordinance takes effect are saved and may be consummated according to the law in force when they were commenced.

Section 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall become effective the 6th day of September, 1997.
