

Our History

Birch Run was originally founded as a station on the Pere Marquette Railroad by John Moore, its first postmaster, in 1852. It was named after its creek, which runs through a large birch area. In 1863, the town was renamed Deer Lick and remained so until 1868 when it reverted back to Birch Run. Birch Run was incorporated as a village in 1955.



Village Government

The Village of Birch Run is governed by a Village President and four Council Members. There is also a DDA Director/ Village Manager, Village Treasurer and Village Clerk. The Village Council meets the fourth Monday of the month at 7 p.m. in the Council Chambers, located at the Village Office.



Fire and Police Department

The Village of Birch Run is protected by the Birch Run Township Fire Department and the Birch Run Police Department. **In case of an emergency, dial 911.**



Department of Public Works

The DPW is responsible for streets, sewer, and water services as well as general upkeep in the Village. For all after hours DPW emergencies, call [\(989\) 624-9856](tel:9896249856).



Voting Site

The Village of Birch Run is voting Precinct #2, Saginaw County District 7. The polling location is at the Knights of Columbus Hall located at 11105 Dixie Hwy, Birch Run.



Village Utilities

The Village of Birch Run offers a utility bill that includes water and sewer. Bills are sent out quarterly, on or around the 1st of the months of January, April, July, and October. Payments can be made in person, by phone, online, thru ACH, or by using the drop-box located south of the flagpole. A late payment charge is added to past due bills.

Payment Plans

The Village of Birch Run makes every effort to work with residents regarding payment of their utility bill. If you are having difficulty with payment, contact the Village office to make a payment plan arrangement. The final payment must be paid prior to the next utility billing cycle. The late payment penalty will be part of the payment plan arrangement.



Tax information

The Village of Birch Run tax bills are sent out on July 1st and are due August 31st. Tax bills are payable at the Village office, by mail, online, or drop box. Scan the QR code above for online payment options.

NSF Fee

If a check is returned for non-sufficient funds or a closed account, a \$25 fee will be issued.

Refuse Services

Recycling, garbage, and yard waste removal is offered in the Village of Birch Run by Mid-Michigan Waste Authority. Garbage pickup is on Thursday. Trash should be put out no more than 24 hours before pickup. Putting garbage out by 7 a.m. the morning of pickup is suggested. Recycling is collected every other Thursday. Yard waste pickup occurs on regular garbage pickup days April thru November. Home Improvements

Useful Ordinances

Anti-Blight

- Property owners are responsible for maintaining their house and yard to safety and appearance standards.

Weed, Tall Grass and Tall Brush Control

- Starting May 1st of each year homeowners are required to remove all tall weeds and grass from their property and the right of way in front of their property. Anything over 9” is considered “tall weeds and grass.”
- Burning yard waste, garbage, refuse, and/or combustible material is prohibited in the Village of Birch Run.

Traffic Control

- Parking between the hours of 3 a.m. and 7 a.m. is prohibited on all streets and in Village owned parking lots.

Animals

- The Village does not license dogs or cats, but Saginaw County requires registration of dogs. It is unlawful to permit any dog to run at large in the Village. Please be considerate of your neighbor when having a dog. Saginaw Animal Control can be reached at (989) 797-4500.
