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6. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

* **Fee clarification-Item #2 RESIDENTIAL HEATING SYSTEM-** This item is used for installation of a heating system in a new residential structure. Items #10 GAS PIPING and #18 DUCT- SHOULD NOT BE CHARGED. NOTE: REPLACEMENT SYSTEMS SHOULD BE ITEMIZED. Item #34 ADDITIONAL INSPECTION-Per Resolution #05-072 on 10-24-05.

Mechanical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with the Village of Birch Run. All installations shall be in conformance with the Village of Birch Run Mechanical Code. NO WORK SHALL BE CONCEALED UNTIL IT HAS BEEN INSPECTED.

The Mechanical Inspection can be made by contacting the Village of Birch Run Office to set up an inspection time at least 48 hours in advance of required Inspection. The Inspector will need the address and permit number.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT. A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced, suspended or abandoned within period of six months after the time of commencing the work.

A PERMIT SHALL BE CANCELED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REINSTATED AND SHALL BE VOIDED.

PERMITTEE MUST INITIAL THIS BOX, VERIFYING THEY HAVE READ THIS APPLICATION FORM COMPLETELY.

7. PLAN REVIEW REQUIREMENTS:

Plans are not required for the following:

1. One or two family dwellings containing not more than 3,500 square feet of building area.
2. Alterations and repair work determined by the mechanical official be of a minor nature.
3. Business, Mercantile and Storage buildings have HVAC equipment only, with one fire area and not more than 3,500 square feet.
4. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00. If work is being performed as described above, answer Section IV "A", plans are not required.

Plans **are** required for all other building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act. No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, as amended, and shall bear that architect's or engineer's signature and seal. PLANS MUST BE SUBMITTED BEFORE A PERMIT CAN BE ISSUED.

8a. HOMEOWNER AFFADAVIT

I hereby certify, the mechanical work described on the permit application shall be installed by myself, in my own home in which I am living or about to occupy. All work shall be installed in accordance with the Village of Birch Run Mechanical Code and shall not be enclosed, covered up or put into operation until it has been inspected and approved by the Village of Birch Run Mechanical Inspector. I will cooperate with the Mechanical Inspector and assume the responsibility to arrange for necessary inspections.

8b. APPLICANT SIGNATURE
